Silver Anniversary: Frank A. Beach Young Investigator Award

Call for Nominations for the Frank A. Beach Young Investigator Award in Behavioral Neuroendocrinology

Nominations are now being accepted for the 25th Annual Frank A. Beach Young Investigator Award in Behavioral Neuroendocrinology. The award will be made to a new investigator, normally within 8 years post-PhD (or MD) who shows exceptional promise for making significant contributions to the field of Behavioral Neuroendocrinology. Investigators conducting original, independent research in any area of Behavioral Neuroendocrinology may be nominated. The nominator(s) should submit ONE letter of nomination. This letter can be jointly signed by any number of individuals of any rank, but the Committee will consider only one letter. A current copy of the nominee's curriculum vitae should be included with the nomination. *Re-nomination of individuals nominated previously, who still meet the nomination criteria but were not chosen, is encouraged.*



The Awardee will be recognized and receive the award and an honorarium at the Behavioral Neuroendocrinology Social at the Society for Neuroscience (in Washington, DC in mid-November 2014). The Awardee will also give a presentation at the Annual Meeting of the Society for Behavioral Neuroendocrinology in Asilomar, California (June
