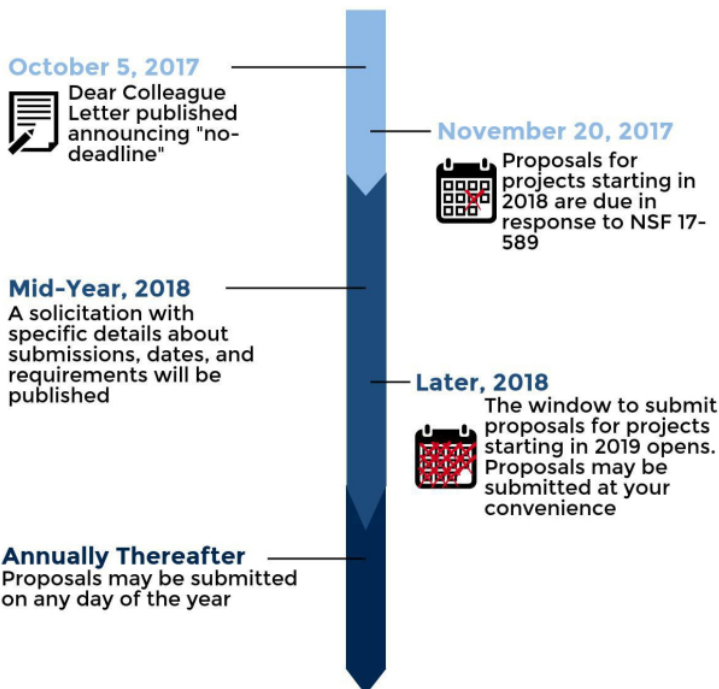
BIO DIRECTORATE GOES TO NO DEADLINE SOLICITATION EFFECTIVE FY 19
